

GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF PHOTOS FROM THE DICASTERY FOR COMMUNICATION WEBSITE¹

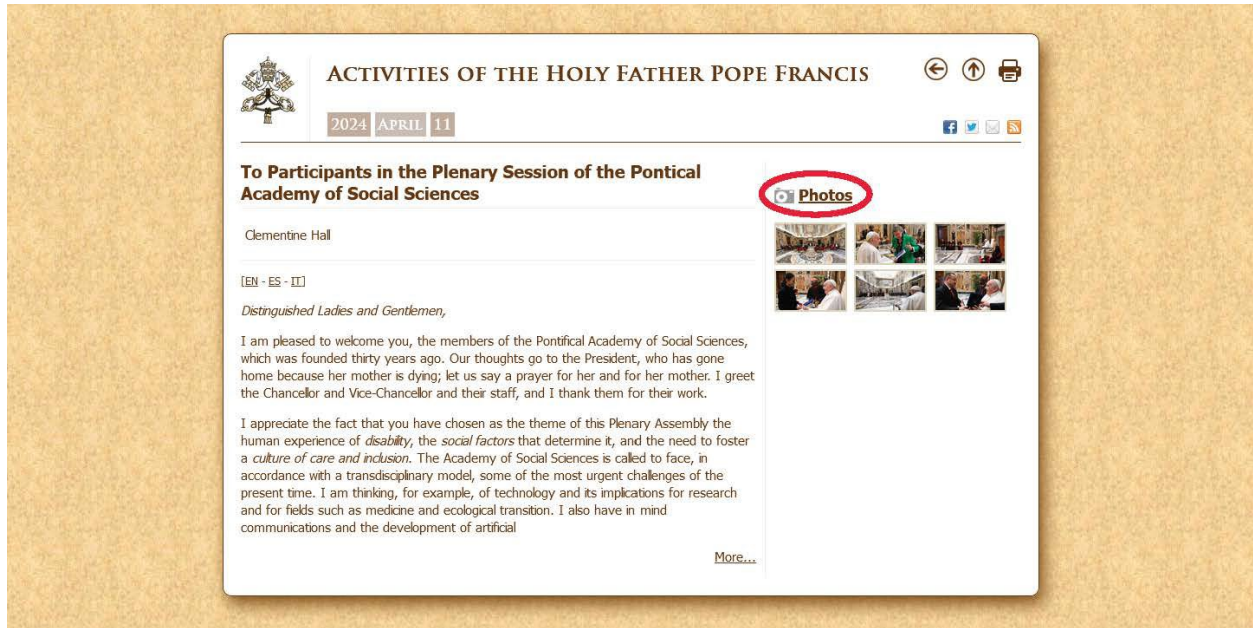
In order to avoid legal action or financial claims due to the publication of photographs belonging to private agencies, the following are some indications on how to correctly use images from the Dicastery for Communication:

- Photos published on [Vatican.va](https://www.vatican.va) are the property of Vatican Media/Dicastery for Communication. You can access the photos by going to Vatican.va and clicking on an event listed under “News”.

- Free use is granted for up to a maximum of 10 photos per month for institutional websites of Episcopal Conferences, dioceses, parishes, and related institutions. The publication of photos must always be accompanied by the “© Vatican Media” copyright credit line.
